





## edgex-compose Release Automation

#### Notes:

- Crawl, Walk, Run...
  - Crawl
    - Update .env file based on steps outlined in the compose-builder README
    - Job just spits out a .env file to the user
    - [strech] Job recommends but does not apply version updates for dependencies i.e. vault, consul, redis, etc.
  - Walk
    - Job generate .env file as described above and pushes changes to a separate branch (pre-"release") in edgexcompose.
    - A developer manually creates the release branch, i.e "ireland" if it does not already exist
    - A developer then manually creates a PR to merge the changes from pre-"release" to "release", i.e. pre-ireland > ireland, this would allow us to create multiple updates in the pre-"release" branch before merging to the "release" branch
  - Run
    - All the steps above, but fully automated and integrated into cd-management/release
