

Summary / highlights from the TSC Meeting 10/7/20

- Placement of conventional commit apparatus is underway across the edgex-project. It should be implemented and the new “law” of the project with regard to PR submission shortly.
- The ADR for generating/injecting random passwords into Vault has been completed. See <https://github.com/edgexfoundry/edgex-go/pull/2659>. The work to implement generate/inject random passwords into vault has been delayed to Ireland release.
- **ADR’s 007 and 010 have been updated and need TSC approval.** The updates have to do with adding CLI artifacts and with Snap releases moving under control of Canonical.
- App services now support HTTP PUT support for export with secrets.
- App services WG conducting discussion on HA concerns (more for addressing getting data off the message bus when there are multiple app services).
- **No App Services WG meeting this Friday.**
- CoAP device service presentation will be made at the next DS working group meeting. This is a new device service to be donated.
- DS WG is working on Ireland scoping. Input welcome at the next DS meeting.
- TestQA is working with DevOps to provide for “smoke test” of changes to developer scripts (like upgrade of infrastructure).
- **TestQA, Security and next TSC meeting (Oct 13-14) are cancelled due to pre-wire meeting next week.**
- DevOps is exploring best way to scan (Snyk) docker images prior to release.
- Geneva branch docs are now cut. Hanoi (1.3) docs are now in the drop down at docs.edgexfoundry.org.
- **DevOps meeting tomorrow is cancelled.**
- Pending important security deliverables for Hanoi still underway are Security Utility, Secure Kong Admin, Hardware assisted protection.
- Kong Summit conference is happening this week. Colin is presenting a workshop on Kong on Friday at 8am PDT. Conference is free of charge and virtual.
- **Endorsement program is nearing completion on workflow. Cert meeting will be held this Monday to finalize (normally a skip week).**
- Intel presented in the next installment of the Adopter Series this week on Oct 6th. See <https://bit.ly/2FNYS1z>. Lenny presented. About 20 people on the call.
- Core working group is focused on V2 API core data for Hanoi.
- If you have items for the Ireland planning meetings (unconference topics, architecture topics, features, etc.) please get with Jim.
- Additional TSC votes are needed to allow a change to committer approval process (single TSC approval for committers). TSC members requested to vote on this today.
- Monthly stats for September were provided. Now at 7.1M container downloads. Committer levels back up to pre-summer holiday levels. Andy Foster provided an update on WebSite stats. We are seeing about 4800 visits a month but September were at about 5300.
- **Topics for next week’s pre-wire meeting were shared. Prewire will be Tuesday and Wednesday next week**
