

Summary / highlights from the TSC Meeting 2/19/20

- All services are in the process to moving to Go 1.13 as part of roadmap setup for Geneva. Core/supporting services and application services report this as being done.
- Work continues in core to have Redis be default for unsecured EdgeX.
- Application services is beginning work to develop a JSONLogic as alternative and simpler rules engine service.
- Bi-weekly status meeting to track the progress of EMQX Kuiper integration with EdgeX is setup of starting Feb 20 @ 3:30pm MST
- The C SDK, v2 API has been merged.
- Swagger and TAF work continue.
- Transformation to Jenkins Pipelines for master branch has been completed. Release branches (such as Fuji) may be converted as needed.
- CLI was reviewed. Some improvements have been requested and work is underway.
- Metrics collection ADR is in draft mode and will be reviewed in system management working group meeting in the next few weeks. This is work for a future release of EdgeX.
- Open Horizon original POC is now in holding; it has been refactored as well.
- Security reports 106 of 119 items done for Geneva release (not inclusive of 8 items in the backlog).
- Vertical solutions WG held its first call under Camilo/Henry and had Intel present lessons learned from NRF demo that incorporates EdgeX.
- Dev advocate shared upcoming events schedule.
- 21 people are currently signed up for the F2F meeting in Ireland.
- Lisa is stepping down from Release Czar after Geneva release. Jeremy Phelps (Dell) has volunteered to take her place. TSC vote forthcoming by mail to approve of Jeremy's role.
