
I. DevOps Work New / Old Review

II. Release Versioning Go Modules

The Gradle Approach (Ernesto) – worked on it and decided it was too much of a hack – shelved it and looking into other options. Also identified a go tool called Go Releaser – maybe for future.

The Concourse Approach (Jacob)

Demo / Discussion of the workflow

Next steps: Iterate using this approach to document the developer / release manager workflow using the tooling Jacob has built.

Focus on the go modules since it would have greater volatility than the services themselves. Use a demo repo for a first sample test and make a decision if this is the right approach to use for perhaps Fuji release.
