



### Delhi Dot Release (0.7.1) - Thursday, 6 DEC

- Feature: Core, Metadata, Logging, Export Client Redis-based services
  - Work towards making EdgeX more database independent
  - Work towards making EdgeX more 32bit available
- Also include some new device services (from the new SDKs)
  - device-random
  - device-mqtt
  - device-modbus
- Work will include some bug fixes not captured in Delhi

## Core Working Group (28-Nov-18)

- Redis code for Delhi 0.7.1 release has been merged
  - Integrated with core-data, core-metadata and export-client
  - For Edinburgh
    - Support-notifications is committed, work not started.
    - IOTech has offered help, in discussion with Redis
- Mongo data model decoupling
  - All of core-data
    - Revised PR #856
    - Blackbox-tests also modified PR #109
  - Core-metadata will be next
    - Could be more than 1 PR to keep things manageable

### Applications WG Update (28-Nov-18)

- Last two Applications WG Meeting were canceled due to holidays and FIWARE Summit.
- Next Application WG meeting is scheduled for December 4
- The next goals are:
  - To define development tasks for the Application Services
  - Prepare proposal for TSC

### Device Services WG Update (28th Nov)

- Both C/Go SDKs supported for Dehli, a few bug fixes.
- C SDK Consul integration done in Dehli release
- Go MQTT and Modbus Device Services are now published.
- C Grove Device Service in process of publication.
- C OPC-UA Device Service in process of publication.
- Published new simple Go "random" service.
- Michael has done initial version of SDK documentation, Cloud reviewing.
- Discussing proposal for new Device addressable format.

### QA/Test WG Update (28th Nov)

- Allure dashboard investigation- verified it works on local Jenkins server for black box test
- Trevor replaced IDs with UUID format in Core-Data test script
- Opened issues for the failed test cases after fixing the incorrect legacy test script
  - 2 in black box repository: #98 and #107
  - 10 in edgex-go: #838 ~ #846, and #848

## DevOps WG (28-NOV-18)

- Delhi dot release coming up (1 week)
  - Should already have rev'd delhi versions to dot version
- New device services (go and c)
- New edgex ui (clojure)
- Volunteer for DevOps WG
- Volunteers to be involved in CI
- Regarding last 2 points; Is there a volunteer to work with me on it and help execute the delhi release?

### Security (28-Nov-18)

- Edinburgh work has begun
  - Starting with more detailed documentation
- Delhi Security Demo next hour in the Security WG meeting
- HW Secure storage design document review next week

### System Management WG (28 Nov 18)

- Reworking start/stop design & implementation
  - Akram working on docker in docker solution POC
- Additional work tasks for Edinburgh
  - Redesign/implement SMA start/stop (part of above)
  - Integrate with Security
  - Incorporate with SDKs/DS
  - Add metrics
  - Add service status health check
  - Create initial transformation (stretch goal)
- System management video available
  - Blog post pending

- Per Edinburgh F2F, demand to define EdgeX support policy going forward for
  1.0 release and beyond
- Jim W on task to draft strawman and present to DevOps WG.
  - Scheduled for next DevOps call
- Using other open source efforts as template
  - Proposing 2 years (or 3 named releases) long term support
  - Proposing 6 months (or next named release) for short term support
- Support defined as:
  - Best effort by community to fix major bugs and security flaws
  - Making all artifacts and other deliverables like documentation available during LTS/STS
  - Making related / required artifacts (Mongo, Consul, Kong, etc.) used for release available during LTS/STS where legally allowed.


