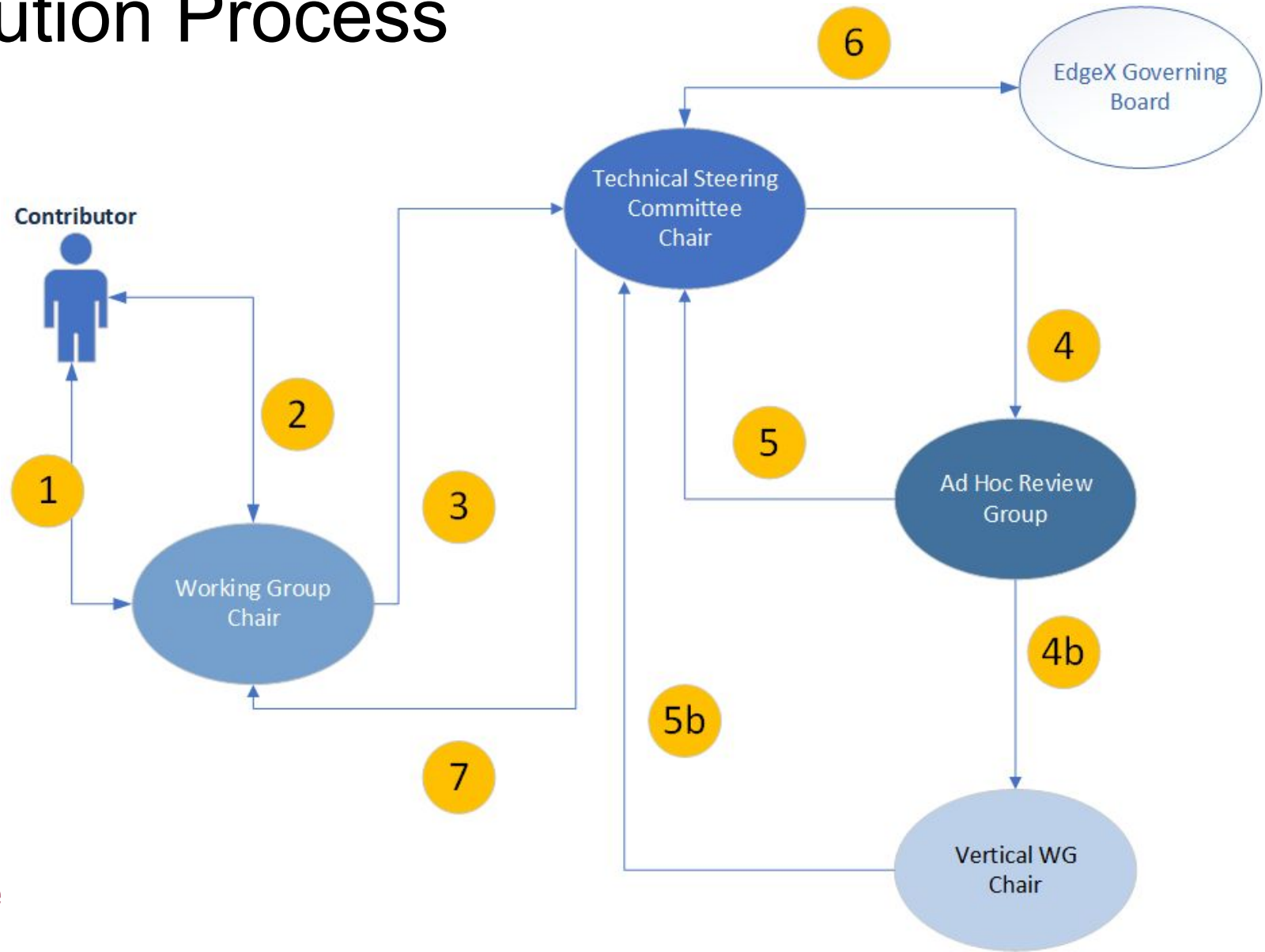

# Smart Factory: Testbed

- Goal: EdgeX-based testbed under IIC in 2018 (and beyond...)
- Current parties : Samsung, Schneider-Electric
  - IIC Membership req : Samsung is IIC member, so no problem.
  - EdgeX Membership req : Start as IIC model (i.e. no problem now...)
  - We prefer to leverage all parties as EdgeX members for better operations
- Current status : Consensus on the top in a high-level
  - “Software-defined” Edge for Smart Factory
  - Testbed accessibility in public : Not decided yet, but prefer to be open!
  - Infra for testbed : have several options, not decided yet.

# Smart Factory : Testbed

- Execution Plans – We need your feedback and support! 😊
  - Re-engage the designated group as Special Interest Group if necessary.
  - Expose EdgeX as many as possible to IIC (like regular IIC F2F).
  - Partnership with Top-tier orgs as many as possible (like Open Group).
  - Publish technical/marketing whitepaper as intermediate milestone.
  - Go through a regular process of testbed establishment in IIC.
  - Set-up a viable laboratory infrastructure for testbed.

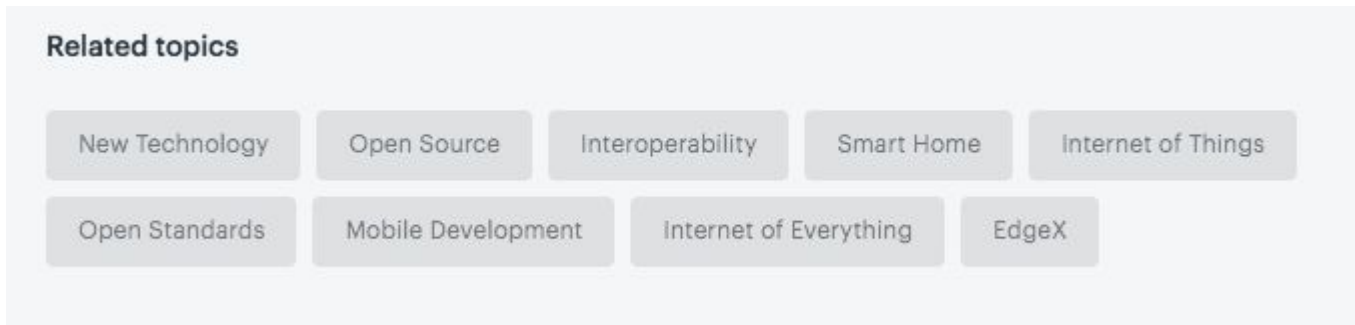

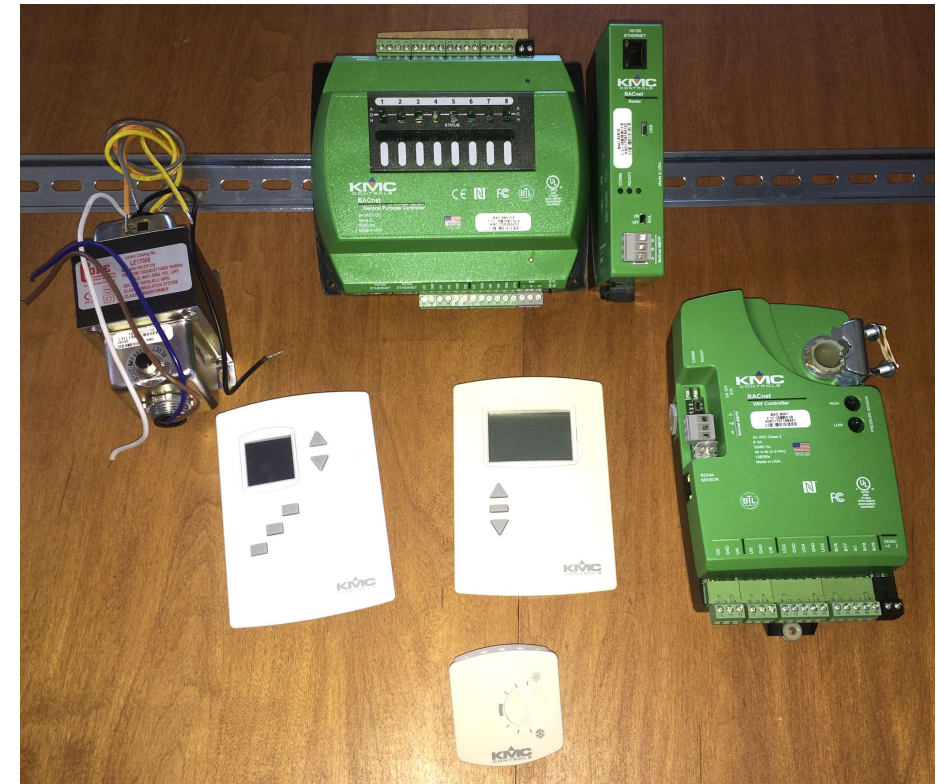

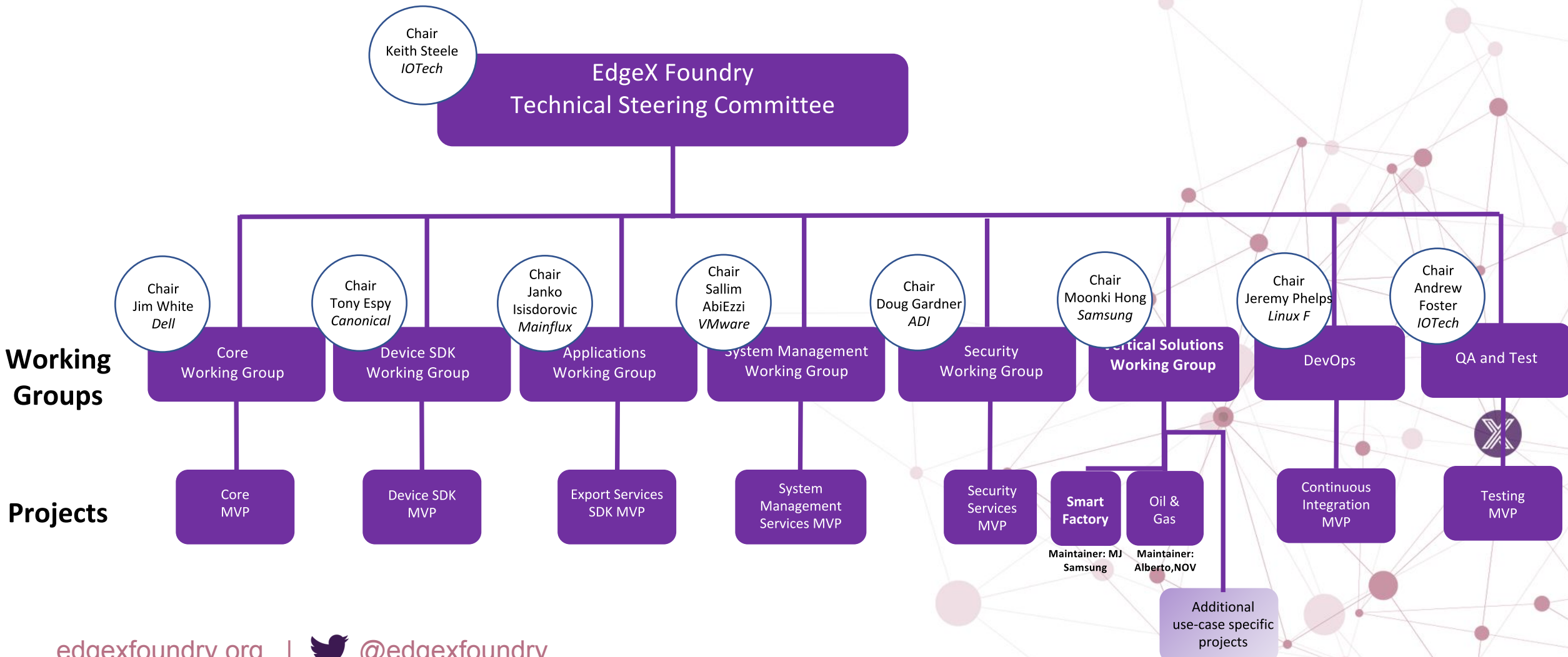
