California Release Planning Summary

- Options: reduce scope, move the date, increase resources
- Decision:
 - Keep June delivery date - June 30th
 - resource levels may be growing, but cannot be counted on to accelerate the delivery without some ramp time (and time to integrate works)
 - therefore, reducing scope

California Release

What is in scope and looks within reach?

- Core Services in Go (all four including core data, metadata, command, config-seed)
- Logging in Go (support service)
- Export Services in Go (including all the current connectors like Google, Azure, etc.)
- Security Services (reverse proxy with JWT authentication, data protection services via vault)
- Device Service SDKs (Go and C)
- REST API Blackbox testing
- Arm 64 support (artifact production and native testing)
- Revamped and improved documentation (in GitHub)

California Release - Scope reductions

What potentially gets moved to Delhi?

- System Management
- Support Services
 - Notifications in Go
 - Scheduling in Go
 - Rules Engine replacement
- Additional/replacement Device Services in Go or C
- Performance testing
- Security testing
- Reduced unit testing across services
- Arm 32 support (artifact production and native testing)

Required California Development Environment

Developer/QA Tools

Accounts and some amount of available cloud resources (number of storage, compute, etc. hours) for

- **Google IoT Core**
- **Azure IoT Hub**
- AWS IoT Core
- Watson IoT Platform
- Pivotal Cloud Foundry Instance
- **Cloud provided MQTT broker for testing various parts of EdgeX MQTT use (export services, device services, etc.)**

Virtual Lab

- Cloud-based environment that is capable of launching, running and monitoring thousands of instances of EdgeX for volume, scalability and performance concerns.
- Also allows testing system management functionality as it relates to multiple deployments

- Devices in this lab would be virtual devices simulated through software
- IOT Pulse System management Test Environment

Physical Device Lab

- Intel and Arm based gateway(s) to run EdgeX
- **Devices** (for those protocols already supported by EdgeX) connected to the gateway(s)
 - BACNet
 - Modbus
 - BLE
 - SNMP
 - Serial
 - OPC-UA
 - Other devices would be added as more protocols are handled by EdgeX
- A small local network may be necessary
- **Internet connectivity and firewall protection**
- **Internet camera mounted over the devices to be able to see any physical actuation**

TSC Elections

- **Election Process In summary:**
- Current TSC terms run through 6/24/201, will initiate elections at next TSC meet.
- The Contributors and Maintainers of each Working Group shall elect a Working Group Chair for their Working Group. Each Working Group Chair will serve as a voting member of the TSC.
- All Contributors and Maintainers in the Project shall elect three TSC at-large representatives to serve as voting members of the TSC.
- The voting members of the TSC will elect a TSC Chair annually, who will serve as a voting member of the Governing Board, and will liaise between the Governing Board and technical leadership of the EdgeX Foundry Project. The TSC Chair... must be representative of a member company.

TSC Elections

Definitions

- i. Contributors: anyone in the technical community that contributes code, documentation or other technical artifacts to the EdgeX Foundry Project codebase.
- ii. Maintainers: Contributors who have the ability to commit code and contributions to a project's main branch on the EdgeX Foundry Project. A Contributor may become a Maintainer by a majority approval of the existing Maintainers.

Process

- Typically managed over email.
- Working Groups manage their own elections. LF can support if needed.
- Once the TSC has been put in place, the new TSC will take nominations for Chair. If there is more than one nomination, there will be a vote.
- One week for a nomination period, and one week for voting (if needed).

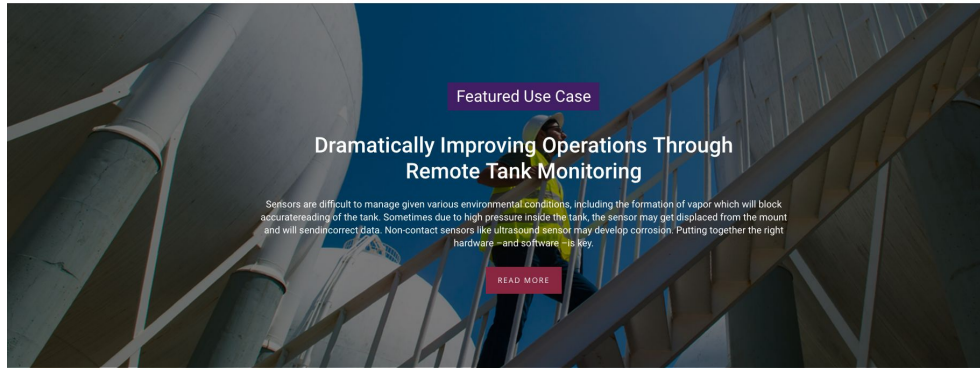

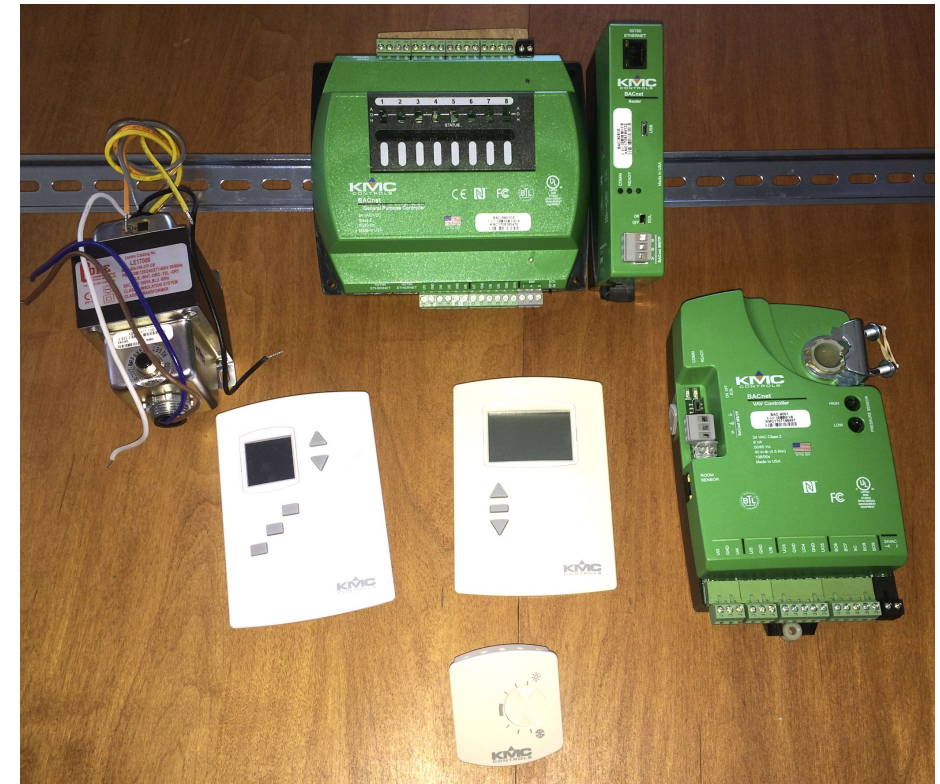

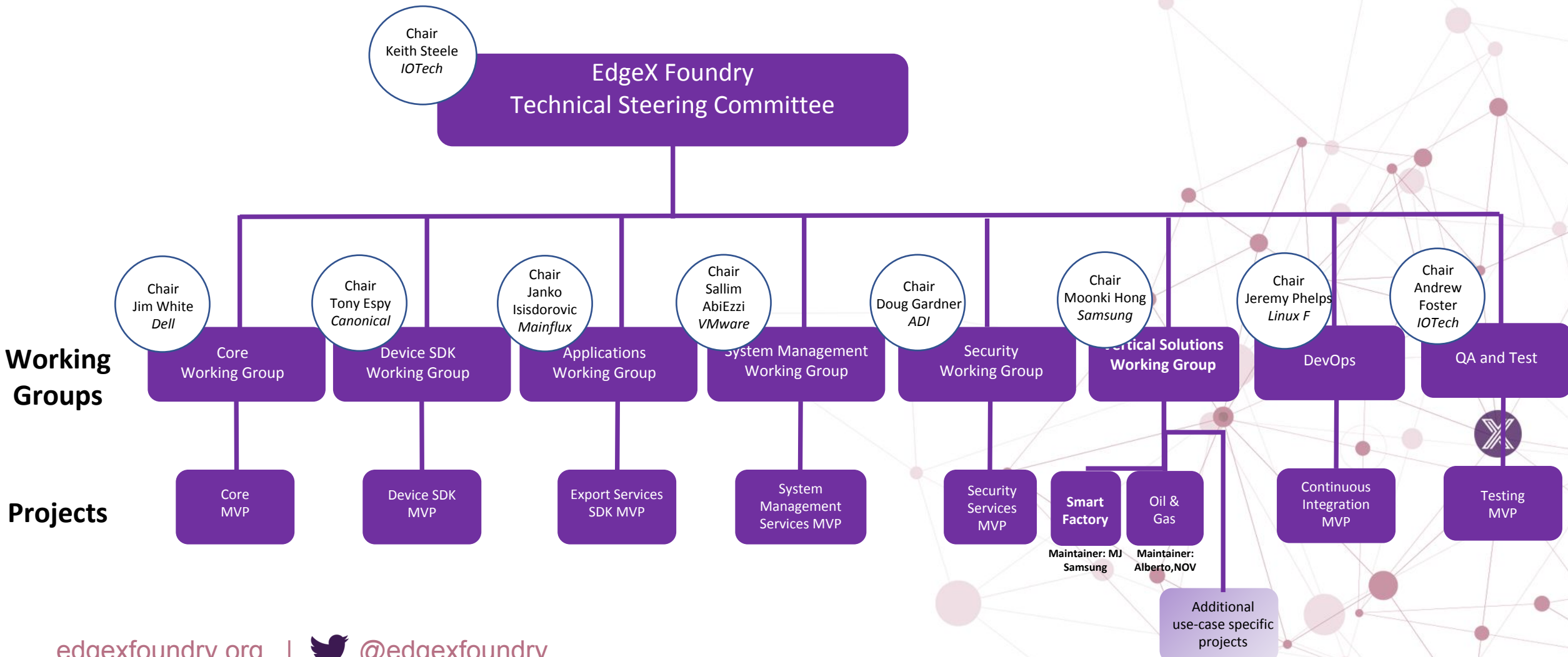
