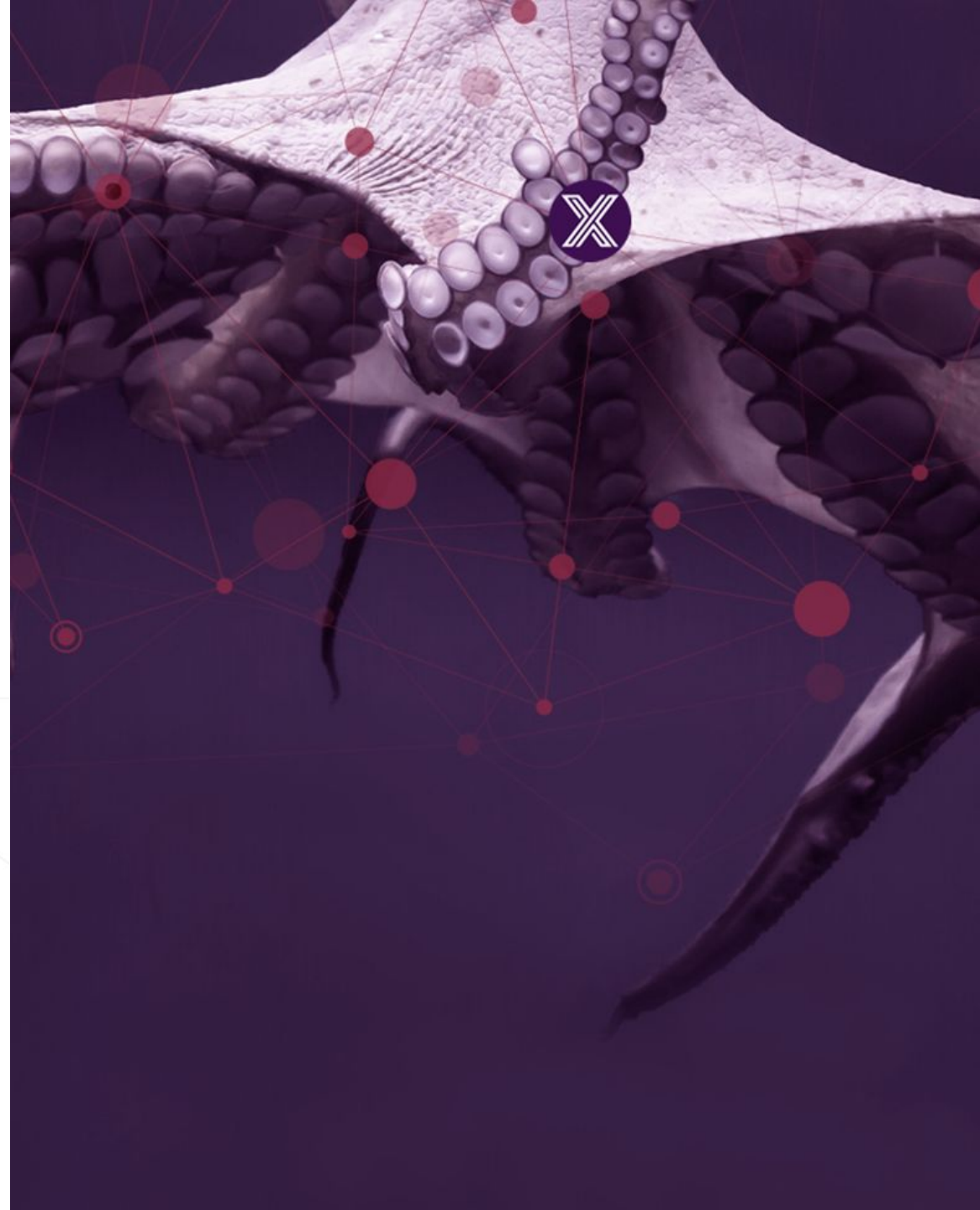

- Process and tools improvements taking place (Andy to address)
  - Build process now all working
  - Docker Build close

# GO Go Lang GO

- For consideration by the TSC
- A number of groups are out ahead of schedule to re-implement microservices in Go Lang
  - Dell on Core Data, Core Metadata, Core Command
  - Mainflux on Export Client
  - Canonical is starting to explore Go DS SDK
- The advancement of Go services suggests we should consider having a coordinated release with all these Go services
  - Timeframe TBD but could potentially be around Dec or Jan
- Would be great to have performance numbers of a few along with formal plan @ time of Barcelona release

# Update 1 of 2

- Build/CI
  - Build process now all working
  - Docker build close to completion
  - Checkstyle to be integrated next for automated code analysis against Google coding standards
- Testing
  - Process has started of getting existing Postman integration tests running from command line and then integrated into Jenkins
- Tools
  - Need to choose a Project Management tool to be used by individual WG and across the organization
  - Candidate tools include:
    - Primary choices - GitHub Projects (available for free with GitHub), Trello (free options only), Jira (extra cost to project for LF support – already ruled out due to cost)
    - Others – Waffle (includes a free OS option), ZenHub (extra cost to project), CodeTree (extra cost to project )

# Update 2 of 2

- Templates and Guidelines
  - Jim has created a new Contributors page <https://wiki.edgexfoundry.org/display/FA/Contributor%27s+Guide?src=contextnavpagetreemode> and started to populate with coding standards, submission license and copyrights, submission DCO and issue tracking guidelines
  - Will circulate additional guidelines for branching model, committing code and versioning to QA Test, DevOps and TSC WG mailing list + post to RocketChat for final comment and then TSC vote to adopt
- Bi-weekly call established with LF DevOps experts to co-ordinate build/test/CI work, next call Tuesday 22nd August (12 noon, EDT)

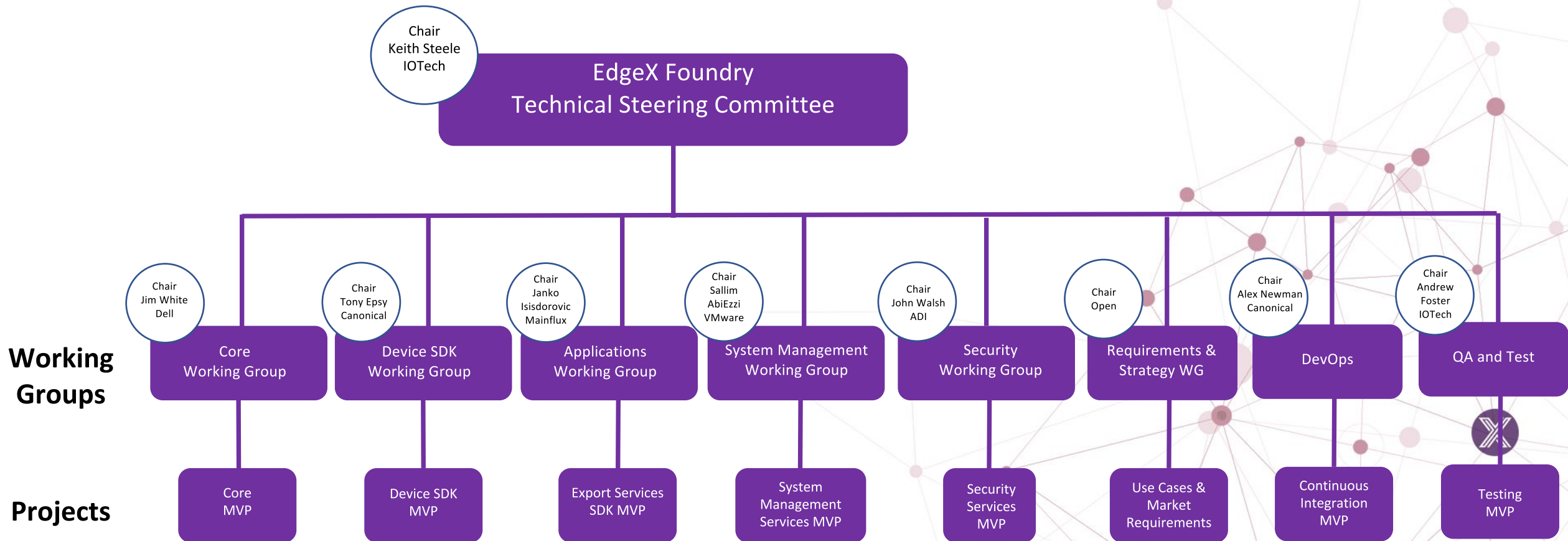

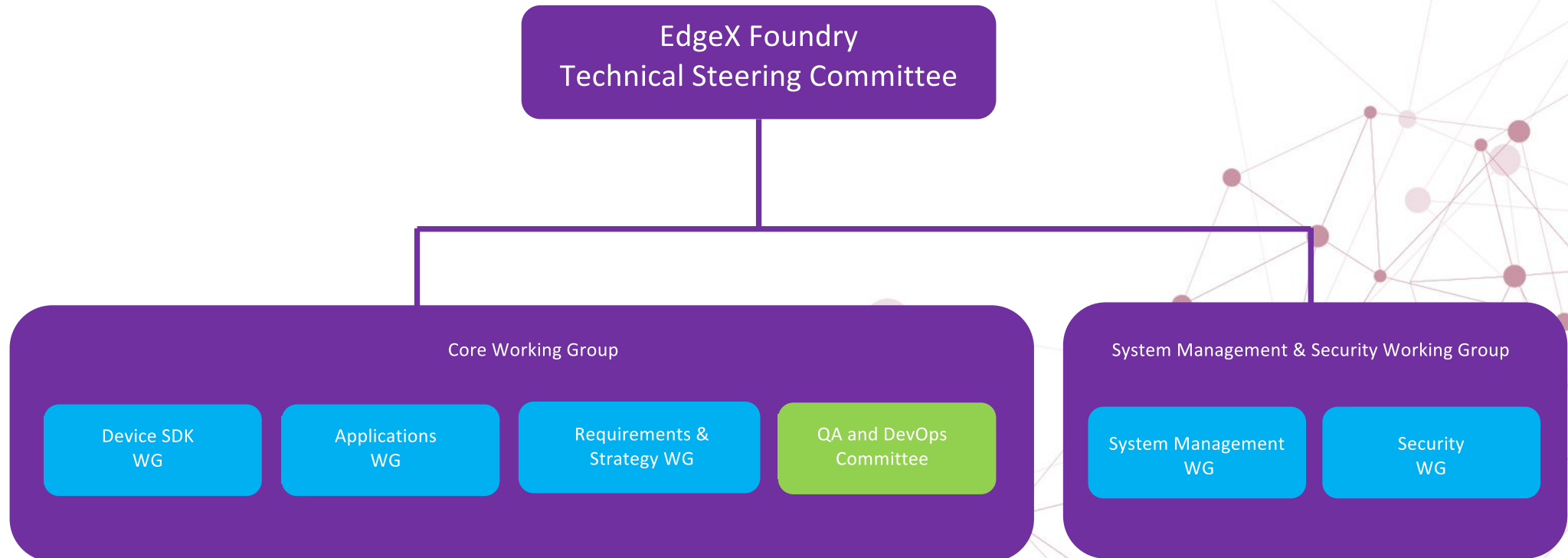

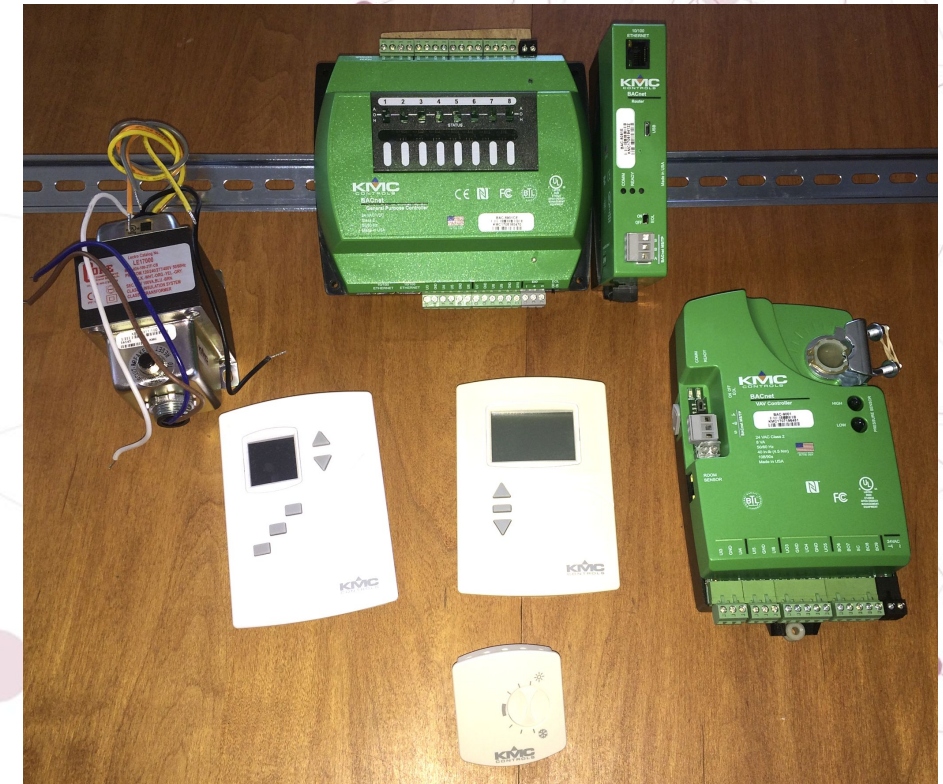
