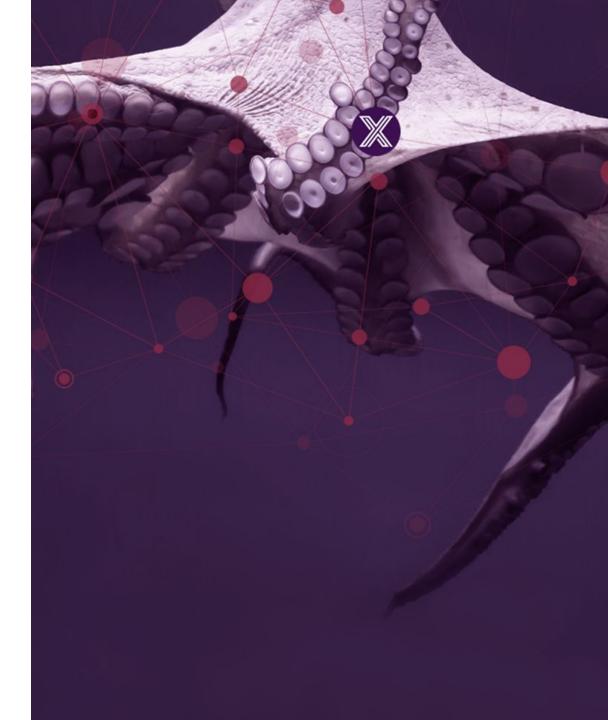

- Data Persistence Project Group completed initial work
 - Will pick back up after DB abstraction and performance test harness in place (~Edinburgh)
- Glide dependencies versioned in master (PR 534 merged)
- Config-seed brought into edgex-go (PR 532)
 - Working with Jeremy on small changes to CI
 - Core-config-seed-go repo to be archived
 - Once merged, work will begin on Config V2
- Still need to tie off restructuring of export services (PR 494)
- Taking a serious look at GoKit (possibly Edinburgh)
 - More robust, modular API router
 - Support for tracing, authentication, microservice patterns
 - Mainflux already using this. De-facto recommendation at GopherCon.

- HRoT (TPM) session held on Friday
 - 5 Intel SME's in attendance
 - Key takeaways:
 - Some combination of Secure Boot + measured boot with TPM is required for complete HRoT.
 - UEFI Secure Boot is the primary secure boot solution
 - Official OS support is limited
 - Best EdgeX strategy for now is to provide guidelines and recommendations for HRoT
 - Secure Storage abstraction will be a focus
 - software by default, HW possible.
 - Interested in an ARM based session in the future






