Summary / highlights from the TSC Meeting 1/13/21

- EdgeX will release a Hanoi Dot (1.3.1) on February 17. All issues / fixes for the release must be identified and approved by the TSC by 2/5. The dot release will include:
 - Metadata update of admin/op status and callback (https://github.com/edgexfoundry/edgex-go/pull/2881 & https://github.com/edgexfoundry/device-sdk-go/pull/652)
 - ZMQ update to fix loss of messages due to system interrupts
 - CLI update to address missing configuration file
 - o It will likely coincide with announcement and launch of the EdgeX Ready program
 - Device Services will release the GO SDK this week (v 1.4.0). We may have additional SDK, DS and App Services as part of this release depending on what all gets included.
- IOTech Systems is making their Device Configuration Tool (DCT) available free of charge to all EdgeX users. The tool can be found at https://dct.iotechsys.com. Users must create an account in order to create and save their profiles with the tool.
 - This tool will also be part of the EdgeX Ready program to be launched in February. It will be used to allow users to build and verify their device profiles used as part of the program.
- Mongo has now been completely removed and/or archived from EdgeX (Ireland release target).
- The device service SDK in Go was released last week (v 1.4.0).
- Custom Trigger registration (app services) is now complete.
- Secret Provider for all has been implemented in the device service SDK in Go.
- All TAF tests are now running
- The Hanoi Performance Report will be published shortly.
- Docker image naming changes is ready for merge (to be coordinated by DevOps and PM).
- The next Adopter Series event will be Jan 19th by IOTech
- Intel, IBM, and HP announce the new Open Retail Reference Architecture sub project (see https://wiki.edgexfoundry.org/display/FA/Open+Retail+Reference+Architecture)
- V2 API work has been completed for Core data & Metadata. Work ongoing for Command and now the supporting services starting with Scheduler.
- Anyone with marketing or other expenditures for 2021 are asked to provide input to Marketing group by Jan 18th meeting. We have \$10K discretionary to spend and we want to plan that during the next marketing meeting (right now it is ear marked for Web site work, China translation, and possibly some UX work).
- There is a internship program (Expanded Mentorship Program) available through the LF.

- WG leads are asked to provide Jim with inclusive language issues by Jan 15th meeting.
