- ARM infrastructure is an issue – across all WGs but in particular it hit security and Test/QA.

- Questions arose during the TSC about when to close down Edinburgh builds.
 - Answer: once we have the Fuji release out and working for the users
- Another question arose during the TSC about whether we continue to provide the older release images and compose files
 - Answer: we keep them out there indefinitely as someone may want to /need to bring up an older version.
 - EdgeX doesn't offer support for these, but the code, images, and compose file should be available if anyone needs it.
- Who takes care of the compose files for Fuji
 - Jim to create the initial set of compose files
 - To be tested by the work groups where appropriate (ex: security WG to test the compose files with the security services enabled)
