Summary / highlights from the TSC Meeting 11-18-21

- Jakarta is released. The following items remain to be done:
 - Releasing the GUI docker image (already in the works)
 - Tagging the CLI branch (to be done today)
 - Creation of the compose files (Lenny has in the works)
- LTS manual tests were completed with those tests that failed rerun in light of the new fixes.
- All Jakarta document items have been completed or will be completed before EOD.
- The TSC approved the release by unanimous consent on the call.
- eKuiper version 1.4.0 has been delayed until early December. Subsequently, version 1.3.1 will be used with the Jakarta release (the eKuiper team will have to provide documentation on how to upgrade if necessary).
- Most work groups have already established Kamakura project boards. A <u>new documentation</u> project board for Kamakura has been started.
- Eaton is working on a new ADR for the combination app/device service ideas and plans to work that through the DS working group staring Nov 29th
- The list of device services made as part of this release: Modbus, SNMP, REST, MQTT, Virtual, Camera (non-LTS). To follow: BACnet, Grove, RFID, CoAP, GPIO
- The security work group has discovered issues with regard to delayed service start and the C SDK. This issue is delaying completion and finalization of the Delayed Service Start ADR. This topic will be discussed in the security work group.
- The EdgeX Challenge China 2021 award ceremony will be held Nov 18th.
- The developer badge system is ready to go (demo'ed by Ernesto at the last dev ops meeting). The program will be announced with the release.
- A new Topcoder contest has been launched to create a developer UI for inspecting messages on the Redis message bus.
- We are looking for sponsors for the EdgeX Challenge 2022. Intel and BSI have committed to be sponsors so far. Contact Jim White to offer assistance.
- ADR status:
 - ADR #268 (metrics) has been revised and seeking comments in advance of the upcoming monthly architect's meeting
 - The service list ADR (#377) has been revised and seeking comments in advance of the upcoming monthly architect's meeting
 - Security WG is working on implication of the ADR for delay start service secret store token in the C development side. Review will resume once that has been addressed.
 - A new ADR (#605) of allowed changes to Device Profiles and associations is available for review.
