- Geneva release is about to go into freeze next week (April 22). A reminder that we will not be branching off master for the Geneva release. No PRs to be created on master during freeze period.
  - Pending work was reviewed. Updated list of what is in and out of release is available on the Wiki (under Geneva Release) and on Slack.
- Lenny to verified that we can create a Kong route for the Kuiper rules engine via the new environment variable on edgex-proxy. To be discussed in Applications WG.
- CBOR library change PR now in.
- App Functions SDK updated to support app service configurable
- Work complete to provide secret support for MQTT secret support.
- App Service Configurable being updated to incorporate MQTT message bus support, JSONLogic and Batch and Send.
- Dynamic discovery work in DS SDKs is under review.
- Pending decision at next week's DS meeting regarding device-bluetooth-c in the Geneva release or done after release freeze.
- Blackbox tests failures around security service are being examined.
- First integration test is out for review (under edgex-taf).
- CLI to not go into Geneva release. Pending decision during WG meeting as to when/where to move it out of holding.
- Open Horizons announced approval to LF Edge Stage 1.
- Topcoder challenge (virtual hackathon) has 9 projects submitted in the contest. Results to be judged ~ Apr 20<sup>th</sup> with results announced soon thereafter.
- EdgeX Award Nominees are final for 2020 (see TSC meeting for list of nominees). TSC members will be emailed voting links to complete for the next two weeks. Winners will be announce during the Hanoi Planning Conference.
