General Web Site

- [EdgeX Foundry Web Site](#) : provides general information about the project, membership (and how to become a members), news/announcements, and governance.

Chat, Q&A and Discussions

- [EdgeX GitHub Discussions Site](#): place to ask a question of the EdgeX developers and community. You will also find project related announcements (such as upcoming meeting reminders, release schedule, etc.) there too. GitHub discussions are persisted and can be searched so users are able to find answers to previously asked questions.
